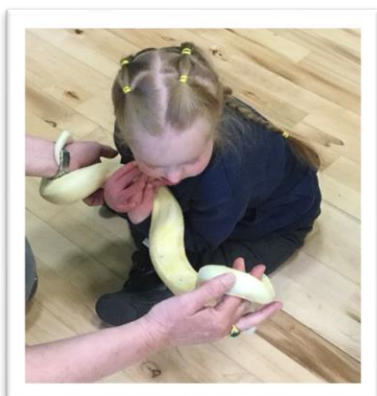
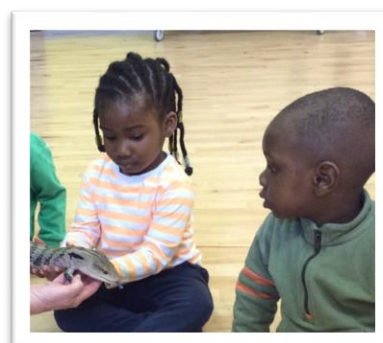
## A Wild Experience
