Dear Parents / Carers,

It is hard to believe that we are heading into the February half term break and therefore have made it half way through the school year! This week, children have been undertaking their reading and maths assessments which will be used in our Pupil Progress Meetings to track progress and identify next steps for our learners. The results from these tests will also be shared with you at the parent consultations which have been booked in just before the Easter holidays; sign up information for these meetings will be sent out after half term.

This week, middle leaders were joined by Miss. Candish, Mrs. Coates and myself to undertake a deep dive in writing. We watched English lessons, reviewed planning, checked books and spoke to children about their experiences of writing in school. Children were very positive about their writing and could explain what they find helpful when writing and spelling. The deep dive helped us to see the progress we have made in our writing provision and identify next steps. Following this deep dive, our professional day after half term will focus on the teaching of spelling and writing which will enable us to make our writing teaching even better. Writing is a key priority in our school development plan this year as we work to help as many children as possible reach the expected standard for their year group.

Today we say good-bye to Mrs. Pearson as she has taken the decision to retire from teaching. Mrs. Pearson joined our school in September 2020 and has worked with many children across the school, offering booster sessions and interventions to help to accelerate their progress. We wish Mrs. Pearson a very restful retirement.
