Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope that you have enjoyed the glorious weather this week.

Firstly, I want to say well done to all the children in Year 1 and 2 who took or retook their Phonics Screening Check this week. Wow! We were super impressed with them! Thank you to the staffing team for your ongoing dedication to teaching amazing phonics sessions.



Over the course of the year, we have asked parents for contributions to run school trips and events. A number of you have been in touch to say that these contributions have been too expensive, impacting your budget negatively. We have cancelled the Wicken Fen day for Year 1 for this reason. It was going to cost £25 due to the ever-increasing costs of coaches. An in-school event, covering the same objectives, will be organised for the children. We are aiming to share with you in September a timetable of the year's trips with both costings and dates so that you are able to budget or indeed talk to us about any financial issues you are facing.

I am awaiting the final budget approval from our trust for September; upon approval, I will then share the staffing structure for next year. Linked to this, we are really excited to also announce that towards the end of term and over the summer, we will be undertaking a reorganisation of the school so that we can set up a new EYFS outdoor space and use the existing space for all children to access at different times. In effect, we will be flipping the school so that Nursery and Reception will go to the current Year 6 rooms and the classes will then work round with Year 6 being in the classrooms near the newer of our trim trails. We will also be updating some of the toilet blocks and undertaking redecoration works in key areas. This will also mean that Sunflowers (nurture provision) will also be in the main building and feel much more included within the school. This will allow the mobile classroom by the back car park to be used once again for wraparound club and holiday provision as the learning resources for Sunflowers will be elsewhere. I will share an updated site map with you at the same point of giving the class structure for next year.

Next week, we have our new Reception starter information sessions for parents. One is at 2:15 and the second starts at 5:00 in the main hall.


