We are very excited about Sports Day on Friday 14th June. Here are just a few little reminders from Mrs Mc Neil for the event:

- ♣ Key Stage 2: 9:00 12:00.
- ♣ Early Years and Key Stage 1: 1:00 2:45.
- Children should be in school PE kit (team coloured t-shirt, shorts or tracksuit bottoms and trainers).
- Make sure if the weather looks hot your child has a sun hat, plenty of water and has applied sun protection.
- Please clearly name water bottles and hats.
- ♣ Ask your child what events they are in.

Safeguarding: Working Together to Keep Our Children SAFE

As the evenings are lighter and the weather improves, it is natural that children are keen to play outdoors. Please remind your child how they can keep themselves safe and ensure younger children are supervised if they are enjoying playing in the local parks and open spaces.

Similarly, as children get older and have access to their own mobile devices, they are exposed to an exciting wider world which can be as dangerous as it is fun.

- Please monitor your child's online activity.
- Please check your child's phone regularly and at least once a day.
- Please consider restricting your child's use of social media by deleting apps which are unsuitable for the age and stage of your child.

It takes a few seconds to share a comment or image online which can spread rapidly and uncontrollably. A thoughtless gesture online, in the guise of fun, can cause long-lasting upset and damage to a young person. This is much harder to resolve and repair than taking responsible steps to monitor and restrict online activity.

Use of WhatsApp and SnapChat outside of school seems to be the biggest cause of bullying and issues impacting children's mental health at Kingsfield. We will continue to educate children about online safety in school. Let's work together to keep our children safe.
