Money raised will be put towards new important sports resources for the school.



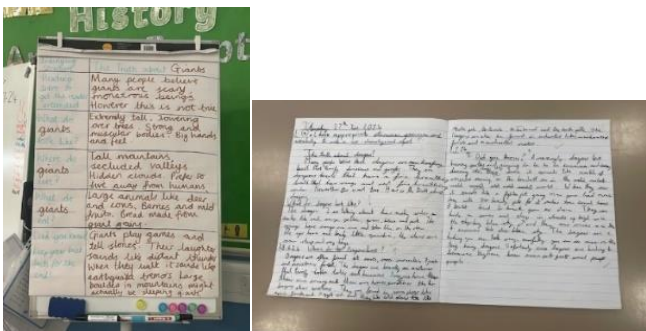
Talk For Writing

Our Talk for Writing approach is developing impressively in classes. Look at some of our writing journeys.

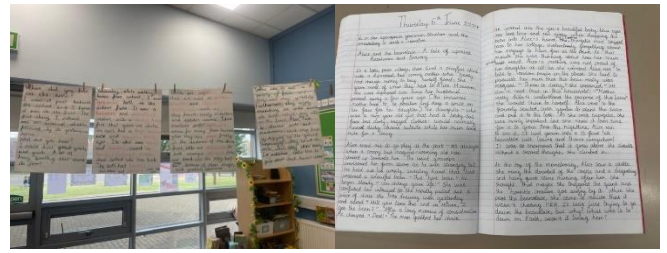
