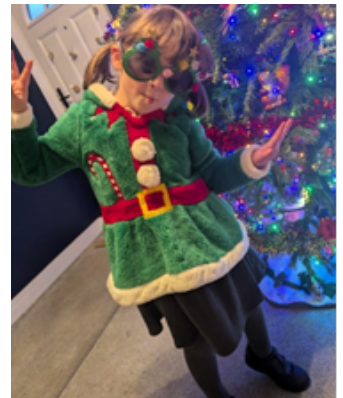
## ISSUE 14 - FRIDAY 13TH DECEMBER
