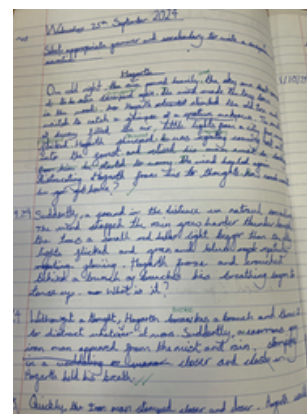
Dear Parents and Carers,

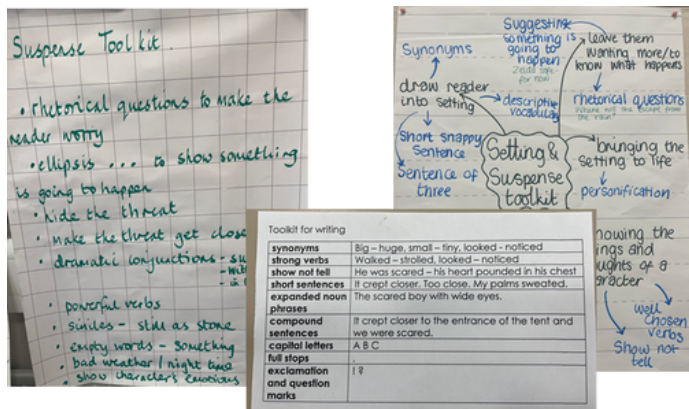


LATENESS
