Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back to you and your children. A warm welcome to all of our new staff and new families.

Over the holidays we have had a significant building programme to replace plumbing and wiring systems. This is almost complete and means that we can now start a programme of redecoration around the school. At the start of this week, the rooms were still being used by the contractors. Unfortunately, this has meant that we have been unable to offer children who require additional support time with their class teacher in school prior to the start of term.
