Book Fair and Library

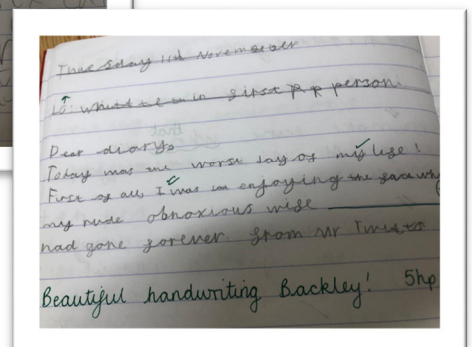
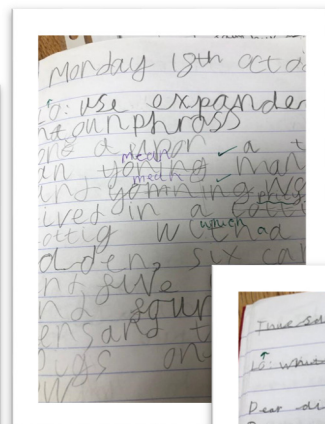
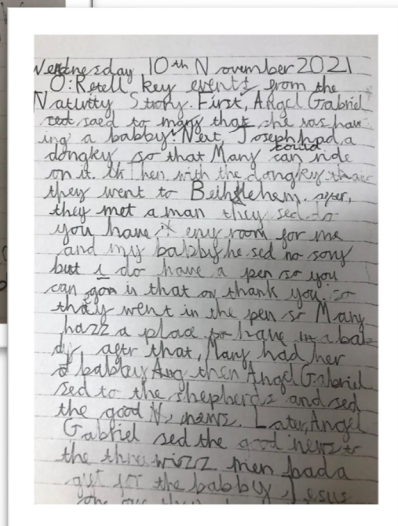
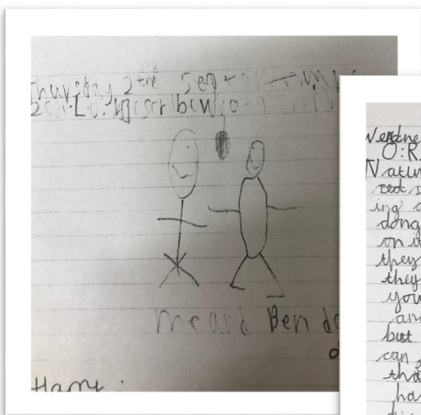
