Dear Parents / Carers,

Yesterday I met with a representative of Premier Sports to discuss the forthcoming holiday clubs. If you have signed up for the one at half-term, you will be receiving additional information about access arrangements next week from Premier Sport. We also talked about the summer holiday club and have provisionally booked the first four full weeks of the holiday. We hope that this will really help families in our community.

PiXL is the Trust-wide provider for diagnostic assessments and we use the software on a regular basis to track children's progress and to find in-class 'therapies' from the system to support gaps / misconceptions in learning.

I wanted to take this opportunity to let you know that Mrs. Stanbridge will be leaving us next Friday and to thank her for the contributions she has made to our school and the community that it serves.

Don't forget that we have a training day next Friday so children are only required to attend from Monday to Thursday.
