As Historians we will:

- Sequence a set of events in chronological order and give reasons for that order.
- Sequence events about the life of a famous person and recount them.
- Explain why Britain has a special history by naming some famous events and some famous people.
- Give examples of things that are different in my lifetime from that of a long time ago.
- Research the life of a famous Briton from the past using different resources to help me.
- Say at least two ways that I can find out about the past - e.g. using books and the internet.
