In PSHE we will learn... (Healthy Me)
about being and keeping safe and healthy.

In Art we will learn...
about the artist Henri
Rosseau and recreate his
famous piece 'Surprise,
Tiger in the Storm'.

We will also carry out some
observational drawings of
spring flowers.



In Geography we will learn...
to identify seasonal and daily weather
patterns in the UK. We will continue to
develop our knowledge about the world,
the UK and our locality. We will use
first-hand observation and other
geographical skills to support our
learning.

In Computing we will...
Look at animated stories linked to
tigers and create a digital non-fiction
book.

In RE we will learn...
continue our learning about the Jewish faith.

In Music we will learn...
about our world. We will listen to music linked
to animals and tigers.
We will explore different sounds, rhythms and
patterns in music.

The Big Question:
*Why are humans not like
tigers?*

In Math's we will learn...
about place value within 50. We will count in 10s forwards and
backwards within 50, secure our understanding of tens and ones,
use tens frames to help us make and partition numbers, as well
as finding one more and less.
As mathematicians we will also explore measurement in relation
to length, height, weight and volume.
We will look at length and height and explore the different
mathematical equipment we can use to help us to measure
objects accurately.
We will also measure weight and volume, and explore the most
accurate methods of measuring and how we can record our
results. We will use words such as long/short, longer/shorter,
tall/short to describe our maths work when we are measuring.
When weighing, we will use the words heavy/light, heavier than,
lighter than to explain our work. For volume, we will use the
words full/empty, more than, less than to explain our work.

In Science we will learn...
To identify and classify creatures,
this will be enhanced by a trip to
Paignton Zoo.
We will name the parts of animals
and humans.
We will talk about what we see,
touch, feel, hear and taste
We will ask and answer questions,
giving simple reasons for the
answers.

In English we will learn...
to write a non-fiction report.
We will explore the text 'Penguins'
to support our writing. This will
also link to our Science.
As authors we will use our
scientific knowledge to inform our
writing about different animals.
As readers we will explore stories
and non-fiction books linked to our
theme.
Children will have specific
opportunities to engage in guided
reading sessions focusing on
enjoying and understanding texts
as well as decoding print. We will
use our phonetic knowledge to
read familiar words, phrases and
sentences. As well as having the
chance to read independently and
for pleasure!
