- Write a story about a magical place based on Leon and the Place Between

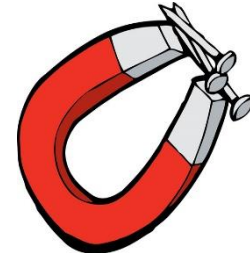
As Artists we will:

As Computer technicians we will:

As Athletes we will:

- Take part in weekly indoor and outdoor P.E lessons.

As Musicians we will:

- Practice singing Three Little Birds and learn this song on percussion instruments
- We will practice keeping in time with other instruments

As Scientists we will:

- Investigate the effects of friction
- compare and group everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet
- Predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other
- Understand that forces need contact between two objects but magnetic forces can act at a distance
- Compare the strength of different magnets
- Recognise that light is needed to see things and dark is the absence of light
- Notice that light is reflected from different surfaces
- Recognise that light from the sun is dangerous and there are things that we can do to protect our eyes
