## English

This term we shall be enjoying the book *Cogheart* by Peter Bunzl. Whilst exploring the text and developing comprehension skills, we will also be focusing on non-fiction writing. This will include newspaper reports, diary entries (recounts) and persuasive writing. There will also be discrete teaching of grammar and spellings.



## Mathematics

We will be following White Rose planning and the focus will be principally on multiplication and division. This will include understanding of multiples, factors, prime numbers and square and cube numbers. We will then be moving on to formal division and multiplication methods. This will be followed by area and perimeter.



## Science

This term we will be looking at different **states of matter**; solids, liquids and gases. Children will explore how to create a solution and how to separate a mixture. They will plan and conduct their own investigation and suggest reasons for their findings using their scientific knowledge.

## RE

Christianity -What does it mean if God is holy and loving?  
Our focus continues to be Christianity, exploring who God is. We look at the two sides of God – his holiness and his loving nature.



## Computing

In Computing we shall learn how to write a newspaper report, using Word.
