Nursery and Reception

Nursery September 2018 starters broadly in line with average
Reception Baseline 2017 – 68% broadly in line with average
68% of pupils gained GOOD LEVEL OF DEVELOPMENT - July 2018
National Average = 71.5%
Moderated by the Local Authority June 2018

Year 1 – Phonics Screening Test

89% passed the Phonics Screening Test 34+ marks
National Average 82.5%

The percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in Year 1 phonics has increased by an average of 19.5% per year since 2016, which is 25.9 times faster than national rate of change. Overall, the percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard at Year 1 has increased by 38.9% over the past 3 years.

Year 2

Progress from Reception to Year 2

Reading = all pupils made expected progress
Writing = 8/9 pupils made expected progress, 1 child made more than expected progress
Maths = 6/9 made expected progress, 3 pupils made more than expected progress

Year 2 SATS

Reading = 66.7% (National Average = 75.4%)
Writing = 66.7% (National Average = 69%)
Maths = 88.9% (National Average = 76%)
Reading, Writing and Maths combined = 74.1%

Reading: Attainment over the last two years is showing an upward trend. 33.3% of pupils achieved greater depth within the expected standard in reading. This is 7.7% more than National Average.

Writing: Attainment over the last two years is showing an upward trend. The percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in Writing has increased by 3.1% over the past 3 years. 22.2% of pupils achieved greater depth within the expected standard. This is 6.3% higher than National Average.

Maths: Attainment over the last 2 years is showing an upward trend. The percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in maths has increased by an average of 12.7% since 2016, which is 4.7 times faster than the national rate of change. Overall, the percentage achieving the expected standard in maths has increased by 25.3% over the past 3 years. 1 child out of 9 achieved greater depth.

Year 6

Progress from KS1 SATS to KS2 SATS

Reading =Broadly in line with National Average.

Writing = Broadly in line with National Average

Maths: Broadly in line with National Average.

Year 6 SATS

Reading Test=80% achieved the expected standard. (National Average= 75.2%) which is higher than the National Average.

13.3% achieved the higher standard which is below National Average. (28.1%) the average scaled score was 103.9 this is slightly lower than the National Average. (105.1).

Writing – Teacher Assessment =73% (National Average= 78.2%)

Maths = 60% (National Average=75.5%) Average scaled score is 99.6

The maths trend has decreased over the last two years.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling=73% (National Average = 77.6%) the average scaled score was 101.3 this is slightly lower than National Average 106.2
