Nursery and Reception

Nursery September 2019 starters broadly in line with average

Reception Baseline 2018 – 66%

83% of pupils gained GOOD LEVEL OF DEVELOPMENT - July 2019

National Average = 71.8%

Year 1 – Phonics Screening Test (11 pupils)

90.9% passed the Phonics Screening Test 34+ marks

National Average 81.8%

The percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in Yr1 phonics at Kirkbride Primary School has risen by average rate of 1.7% per year since 2017, which is 4.9 times faster than the national rate of change. Overall, at Kirkbride Primary School the percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard in Y1 phonics has increased by 3.4% over the past 3 years.

Year 2

Year 2 SATS (10 pupils)

Reading= 70.0% (National Average= 74.9%)

Writing =70.0%% (National Average=69.2%)

Maths =70.0% (National Average= 75.6%)

Reading, Writing and Maths combined= 60%

Reading: the percentage of students achieving the expected standard in reading at Kirkbride has risen by an average of 3.8% per year since 2017. Overall, at Kirkbride the percentage achieving the expected standard in reading has increased by 7.5% over the past 3 years. At Kirkbride Primary School 10.0% of students achieve greater depth within the expected standard in writing.

Writing: The percentage of students achieving the expected standard in writing at Kirkbride Primary School has risen by an average of 3.8% per year since 2017. Overall, at Kirkbride Primary School the percentage achieving the expected standard in writing has increased by 7.5% over the past 3 years. At Kirkbride Primary School 20.0% of students achieve greater depth within the expected standard in writing.

Maths: the percentage of students achieving the expected standard in maths at Kirkbride has risen by an average of 3.8% per year since 2017. Overall, at Kirkbride the percentage achieving the expected standard in reading has increased by 7.5% over the past 3 years. At Kirkbride Primary School 30.0% of students achieve greater depth within the expected standard in writing.

Year 6

Year 6 SATS (5 pupils)

Reading Test=80% achieved the expected standard. (National Average= 73.1%) which is higher than the National Average.

The average scaled score was 100.4

No children reached the higher standard.

Maths Test = 60% (National Average=75.5%)

0% achieved the higher standard.

The average scaled score was 101.8

No children reached the higher standard.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling=60% (National Average = 78%)

The average scaled score was 101.2

Reading, Writing and Maths combined = 60% (National Average 64.8%)
