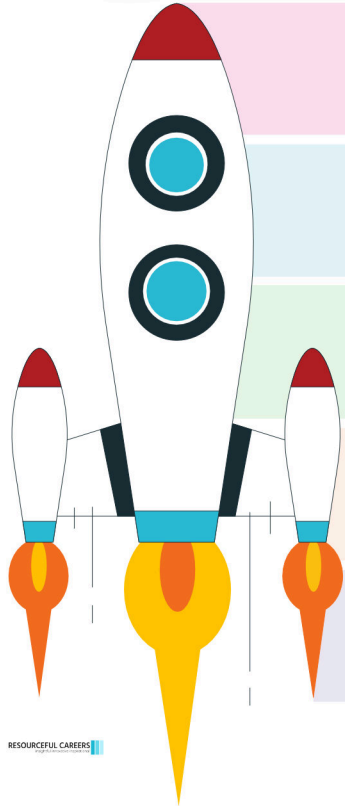

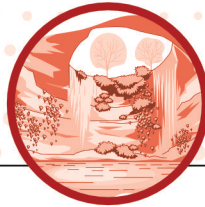

Advise on sustainability, including waste management, recycling, flood risk and the effect of climate change.

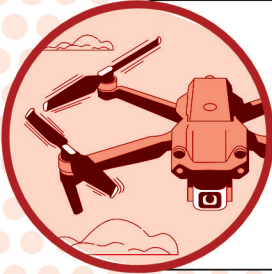
