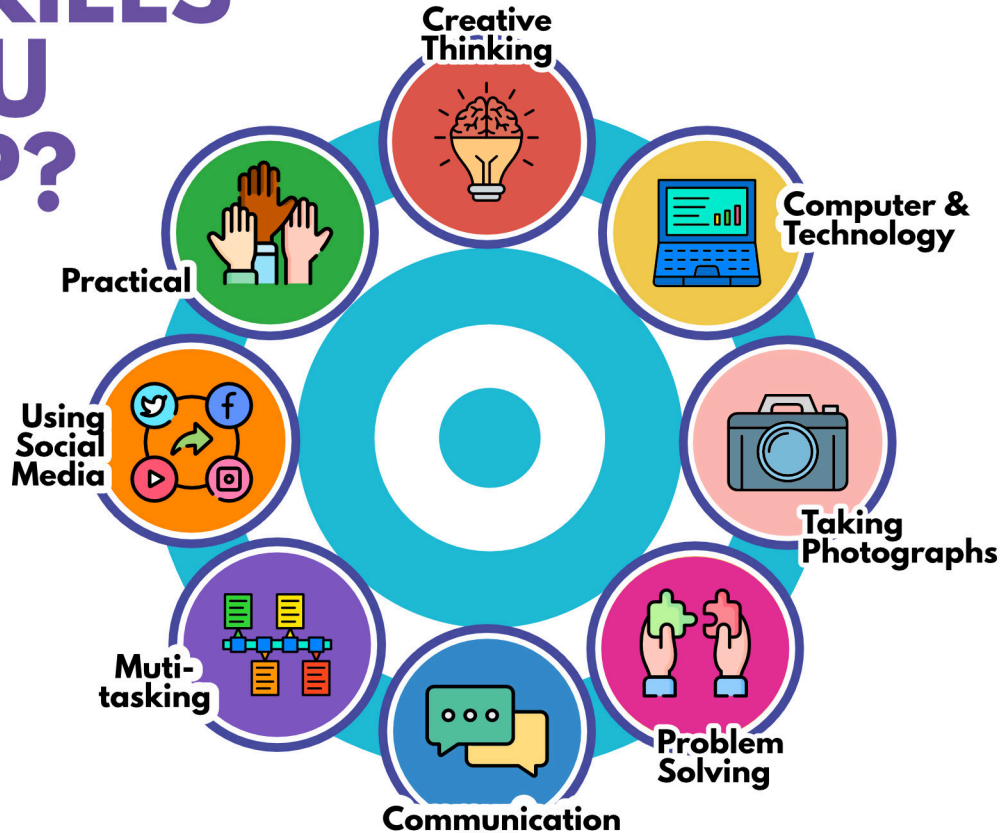

Create visual branding, adverts, brochures, magazine, website designs, product packing and displays.

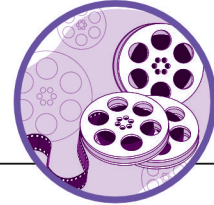
