Let them explore lots of ranges of media. Home Bargains and The Works have reasonably priced art materials.


Visit an art gallery, as they will soon be opening their doors again. The Yorkshire Sculpture Park is on your doorstep

I will be running a competition to design the front cover of next year's planner. More details to follow soon .....







Pupils have been completing their Cubist still life pictures in mixed media and are starting studying Art relating to Dai de los Muertos.




## Year 7

## Andrea Knowles


Andrea lives in Shelley .She works part time as a local community nurse and also a part time artist mainly producing pet portraits.


