## Message from the School Council

Dear Parents,

During our School Council meetings, where we have pupil representatives from I2 through to J4, we have all discussed how much we would like to support those children in Ukraine who are currently in significant need. We have therefore decided together that we would like to raise money for Save the Children.

Children make up around half of those who have fled the conflict in Ukraine thus far, with figures currently estimated at one million children. Around 7.5 million children in Ukraine are now in danger. Save the Children is focused on the needs and protection of these children, and is a member charity of the Disasters Emergency Committee; they provide urgent supplies including the distribution of food and water, shelter and medical care.

Should you wish to support our appeal to help the children of Ukraine, please note that we will have donation buckets placed at the entrance points of Pre-School and the Junior and Infant building at the start and end of the day on Monday 14 March.
