THE ROLE

Required for September 2024, a dynamic, creative and enthusiastic teacher to join the Design & Technology Department.

The successful candidate will have a sound command of the subject, be familiar with current trends in Design Technology teaching, and have a desire to innovate and challenge. He/she will be able to teach Design Technology from Year 7 to Year 11. An opportunity to contribute to the teaching at A Level may be available. Following on from the in-house KS3 DT content delivered to all pupils, the department offers pupils OCR GCSEs in Product Design and Design Engineering at KS4; and OCR Design Engineering and AQA Product Design A Levels at KS5.

The department is housed in a superbly equipped, purpose built building. The ground floor consists of a design area housing a suite of networked computers, interactive whiteboard and two 3D printers. A second room houses a Systems and Control area which includes a suite of networked computers, a PCB production area, PIC programming facilities and electronics equipment. This room also has its own dedicated interactive whiteboard. The third room is a large multi-purpose workshop area with 2 laser cutters and a wide range of materials processing equipment.
