## BACKGROUND

Kirkham Grammar School is an independent school, comprising a Senior, Junior, Infant and Pre-School, with 850 pupils on roll. The Senior School has 650 pupils in an age range of 11 - 18 years. There are close links with the Junior, Infant and Pre-School, situated across the road, which has 200 pupils on roll. The Governing Body and Bursarial Department are common to both schools.

# THE ENGLISH DEPARTMENT

The English Department is a lively, vibrant, successful part of Kirkham Grammar School. It comprises seven experienced teachers, wholly committed to their pupils' success and the broader life of the school.

Literacy and teaching through text is at the heart of the department's teaching. The schemes of work grow from this and allow individual specialism and the profiles of different classes to be accommodated. There is close liaison with the Drama Department, the Library and the SEN team and this adds to the pupils' cultural enrichment. So too does the wide range of cocurricular activity which includes theatre trips, visiting writers and performers, cultural visits, poetry writing competitions and essay writing events. Sixth Form students are also encouraged to become involved in the many university events available to them.

At Key Stage 4, English Literature and English Language are taught to the Edexcel International GCSE for UK Schools Specification, with strong results every year. At A level, candidates study the Edexcel specification for English Literature and the AQA specification for English Language.

The department thrives on its ability to balance a desire to work independently with a strong team ethos. There is positivity and good humour brought to the department's classrooms where very high expectations are set, and the department shows an ability and commitment to work with passion and enthusiasm at all times. Strong subject knowledge is key.
