#### Key Responsibilities:

Support the Summer School Activity Lead in running a varied programme of co-curricular activities that are enjoyable, age-appropriate, and accessible to all students.

- Help create a positive, welcoming atmosphere where students feel encouraged, included, and confident to try new things.
- Assist with supervision, behaviour management, and pastoral care to ensure the wellbeing and safety of all participants.
- Contribute to the smooth running of excursions.
- Engage actively with students, fostering social integration between British and international participants.
- Help with set-up, organisation, and resource preparation for activities as directed by the Activity Lead.
- Communicate effectively with staff and students, promoting high standards of conduct and teamwork.

#### Working Hours and Pay:

- Must be available for the entire duration of the Summer School from Sunday 19/07/2026 through to Sunday 02/08/2026.
- Required at a minimum Monday to Friday, 7 hours daily for 10 days, paid at **£12.71 per hour**. The individual timetable will be agreed with the Course Director closer to the time.
- Occasionally required to stay overnight on a rota basis from 11:00pm–9:00am at an additional **£50 per night** (subject to being over 18). Overnight rota dates will be set in advance by the Summer School Course Director.
