First Login

Google Classroom

Google Classroom is designed to help teachers and students communicate and collaborate, manage assignments paperlessly, and stay organised. Google Classroom is part of the Google Apps for Education suite of tools and is only available to Google Apps for Education accounts.


First Login

Please Go to classroom.google.com.

Copy or type the above address in your web browser, click return. You will be taken to the Google sign page in for Google Classroom website where you will see a screen like the one on the right.

In the first instance you will use your gmail assigned to you via your your teacher's email. Type in your gmail (surnameinitial@kirkhamgs.co.uk) then enter the password Passw0rd (case sensitive). You will then be asked to enter your own password, do so and make a note. Accept the new account.

1. Enter gmail given by school: surnameinitial@kirkhamgs.co.uk



2. Enter Pass0rd then you will be asked to fill in a new password.






You should see a welcome message from your teacher on the stream. Why don't you say hello so I know you have made it

Now to link with your phone ...


- Get your phone out ...
- Please download the Google Classroom App from Play Store or App Store on your phone
- Open the App and login with your new account
- Click to open the Gsuite Training classroom
- You should now be able to see the same Stream homescreen with the welcome messages on
- The next slide will demonstrate how easy it is for a student to hand in a photo of their work directly to your classroom



Now to take a photo ...


- Please take a photo of something nice in your house (pet, flower, fruit etc)
- Go back to the Google Classroom App on your phone
- Click to open your classroom
- At the bottom of the screen click on 'Classwork'
- Click on 'Photo Hand in Point'
- Swipe up where is says 'Your work'
- Click on ' + Add attachment'
- Click on 'File '
- Choose a photo to add
- You can add more than one by clicking '+ Add attachment' again
- When you are finished, click 'Hand In 'and your phone will tell you when the work is submitted





Using Google Classroom


