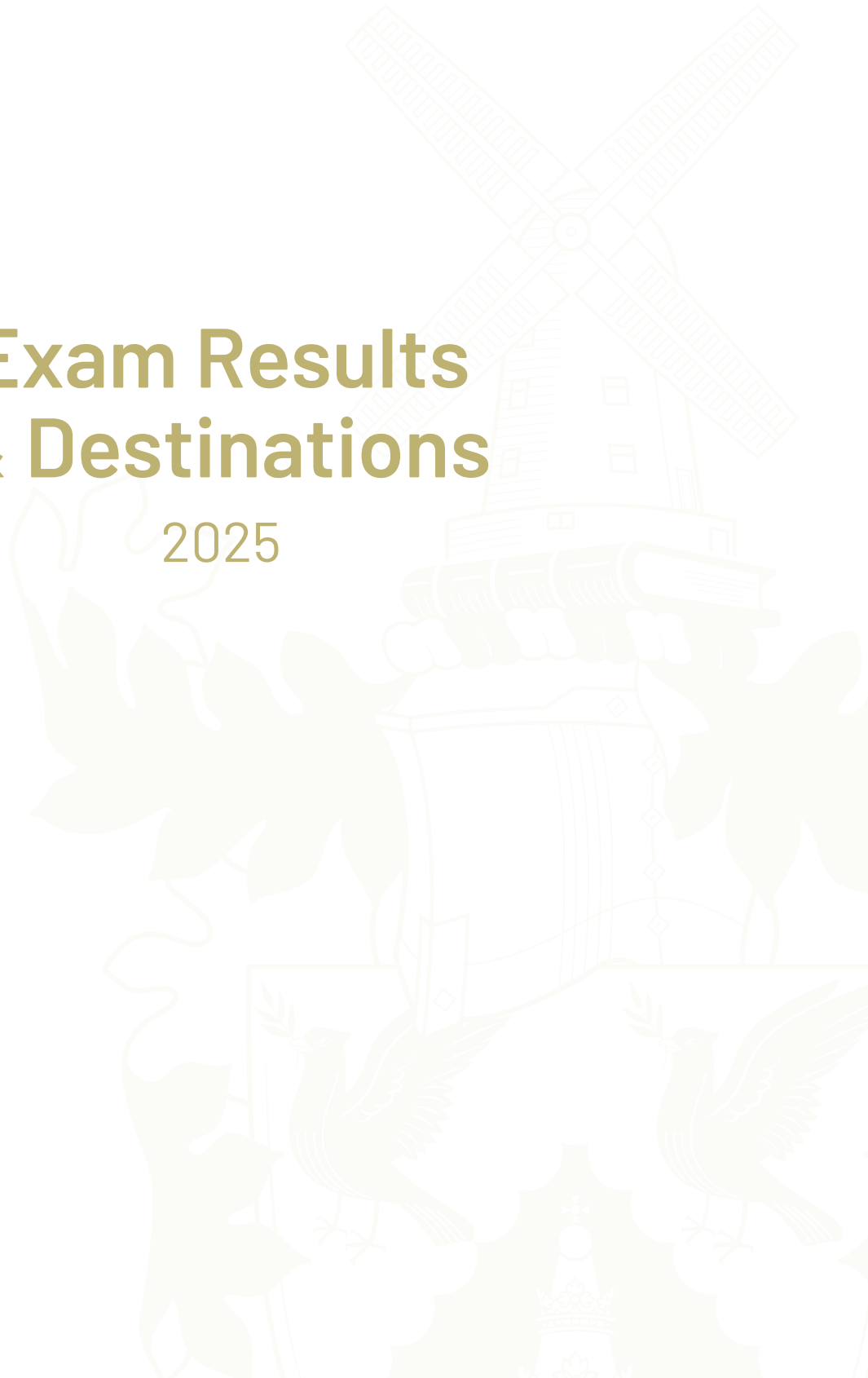

We are pleased to share that pupil outcomes reflect **strong academic achievement** across a range of qualifications, and **far exceed national averages**, highlighting the **dedication of our staff** and the **commitment of our pupils**.

With **100% pass rate**, our **BTEC** provision continues to grow in strength and relevance, offering valuable pathways that complement our academic curriculum. Our pupils also achieved a **100% pass rate in the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)**, a qualification that develops independent research and academic writing skills. The EPQ strengthens university applications while fostering intellectual curiosity and self-directed learning, key traits for future success.

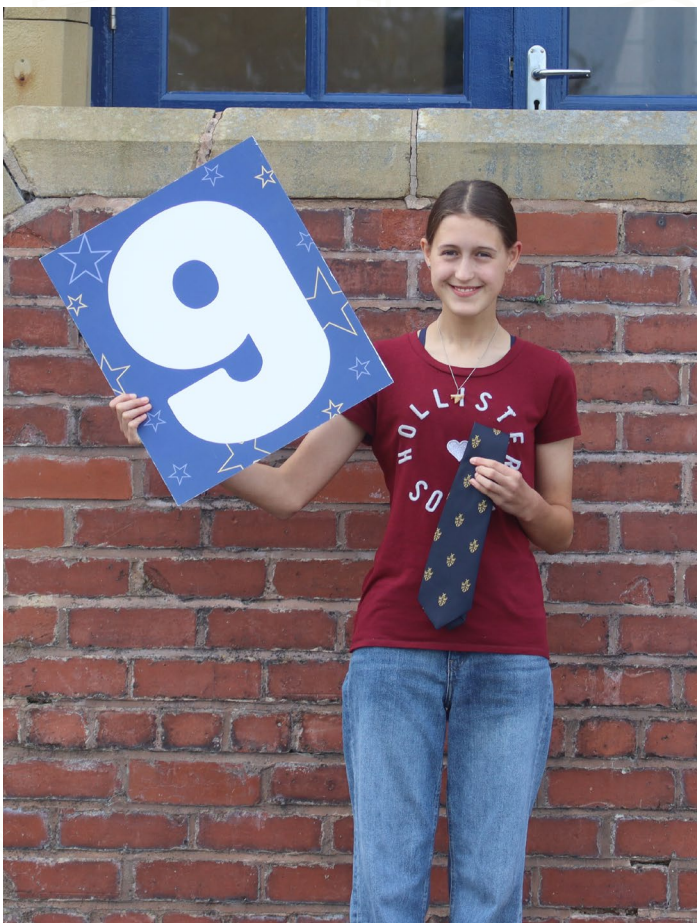
Our **Average Point Score per pupil** remains well above the national average, underscoring the strength of our pupils' performance across all subjects.

In both, we outperform the national average of those achieving a Grade 4 or above by over 15%.

These core subjects are not only central to academic success but also serve as **key indicators of future achievement**. Proficiency in these subjects **underpins performance across the curriculum** - from scientific analysis and historical interpretation, to logical reasoning and effective communication.

A Level Results & Sixth Form Destinations 2025:

Celebrating Success and Supporting Diverse Pathways

We are proud to share that 74% of Kirkham Grammar School Upper Sixth Form leavers **secured a place at their preferred choice university in 2025** - a remarkable achievement that reflects both academic excellence and the strength of our guidance and support systems. In addition, almost **40% of our pupils accepted places at Russell Group Universities.**

In addition to university progression, the 2025 cohort embraced **alternative, viable and increasingly lucrative pathways**, with pupils accepting **high-quality apprenticeships at leading organisations including GXO Logistics, BAE Systems and AtkinsRéalis.**

Our Sixth Form students achieved a **96% A Level pass rate, with a point score of 99 per pupil - exceeding national averages.** With 18% of grades at A*-A and 69% at A*-C, our results reflect **consistently high levels of achievement.**

The results and destinations of our pupils highlight our **commitment** to preparing pupils for a **range of futures**, tailored to their **individual strengths and aspirations, in addition to the hard work of our pupils and staff.** Whether pursuing higher education or entering the world of work, our pupils leave KGS equipped with the **skills, character and confidence** to thrive in their chosen fields.

Kirkham Grammar School **values the diverse paths** our Sixth Form pupils pursue with their qualifications.
