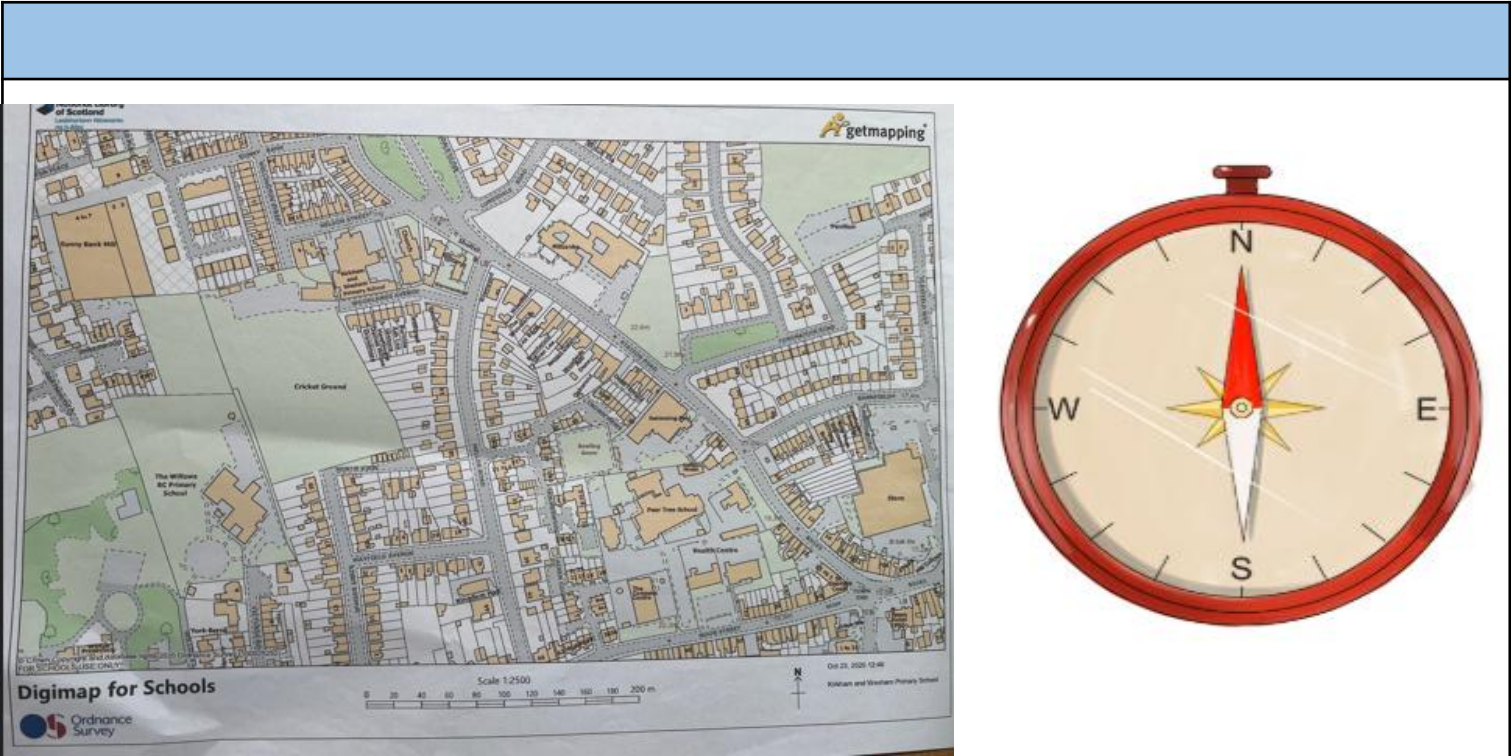


Kirkham Expedition – The Local Area



ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY	
Word	Definition
landmark	A feature (e.g. building, statue, bridge, mountain or park) that is easily recognised and helps people know where they are.
aerial	From up above.
human feature	Made by people. Something that would not be there without humans.
physical feature	Something that is natural and was not made by humans.
compass	An object that helps you find direction.
route	A way to get from one place to another.

Key Concepts
