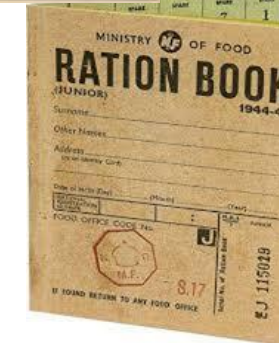
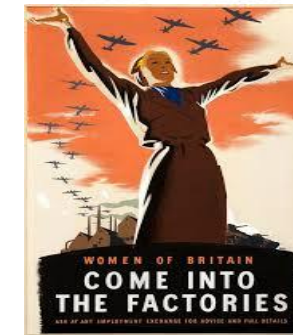
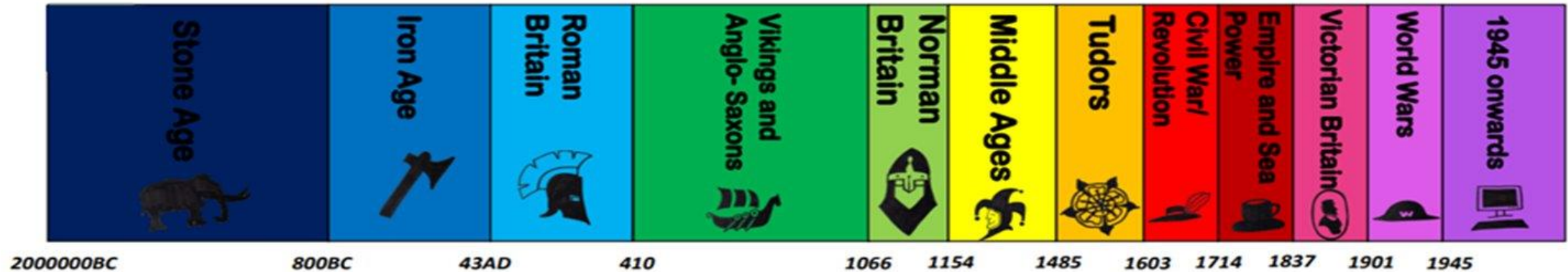


What was it like for children during WW2?

Propaganda	A way of spreading information, ideas or images to persuade people to think a certain way.
Rationing	A system where a government controls access to a product or service and decides how much a person is allowed to buy or use.
Allies	A group of countries who joined forces to fight. This include UK, France and USA.
Axis powers	A group of countries who fought against the allies. This include Germany, Italy and Japan.
Evacuated	To move children from the cities to the countryside for safety.
