The Calling of the First Disciples

(Based on Matthew 4:18–22)

Jesus walked along the shore of the Sea of Galilee and saw two brothers, Peter and Andrew, throwing their nets into the water. They were fishermen. Jesus called, "Come, follow me! I will make you fishers of people." At once, they dropped their nets and followed him.

A little further on, Jesus met James and John, fixing their nets with their father. He called them too— and immediately they left their boat and followed him. From that day on, the disciples walked beside Jesus, learning, helping others, and sharing God's love wherever they went.
