A graduated circle printed on a map or chart from **Compass rose** which compass points can be taken. An object or feature of a landscape or town that is easily seen and recognised from a distance, Landmarks especially one that enables someone to establish their location. **Physical** The branch of geography dealing with natural features. geography The branch of geography dealing with how human Human activity affects or is influenced by the earth's geography surface. A mark or character used as a conventional **OS symbols** representation of an object, function, or process. A line on a map joining points of equal height above **Contour lines** or below sea level.
