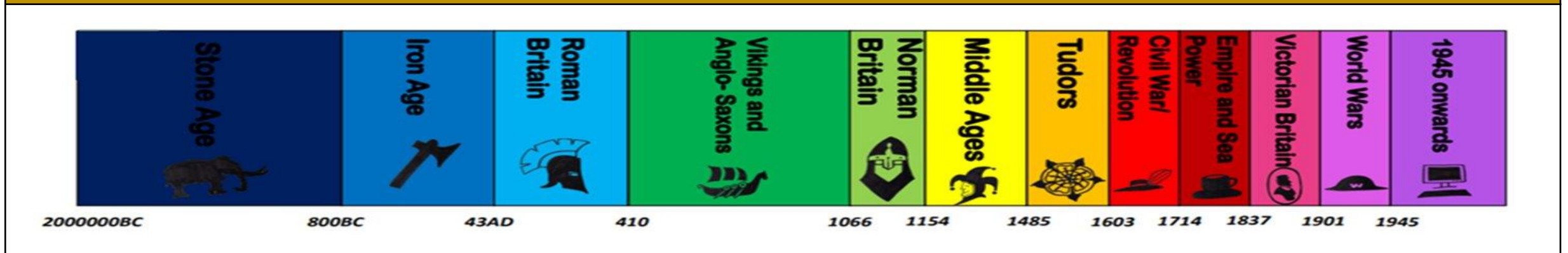
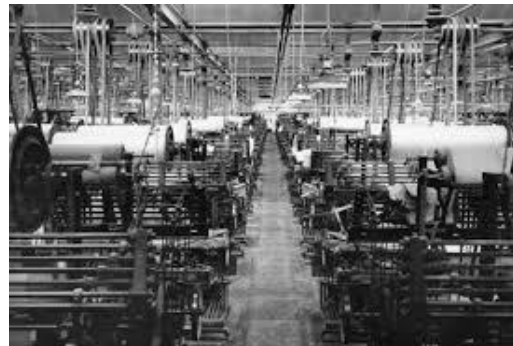

Mill	A factory where materials like cotton are processed into cloth.
Working conditions	The environment and rules that people experience while doing their jobs.
Wealthy	Having a lot of money and a comfortable lifestyle.
Factory Act (1874)	A law that improved safety and limited working hours for workers, especially children.
