



Timeline



ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY

Archaeologist	A person who studies history by digging up objects and using them to tell us about the past.
Invaders	People who enter an area and take control of it by force.
Picts	Tribes originally from Scotland generally feared.
Angles, Jutes, Saxons	Tribes from Europe that settled in Britain around 450AD.
Kingdom	An area ruled by a king or queen.
Anglo-Saxon Kingdoms	Northumbria, Mercia, East Anglia, Wessex, Essex, Kent, Sussex.
Sutton Hoo	An Anglo-Saxon burial site.
Paganism	The early religion of the Anglo-Saxons worshipping many gods and goddesses.
