

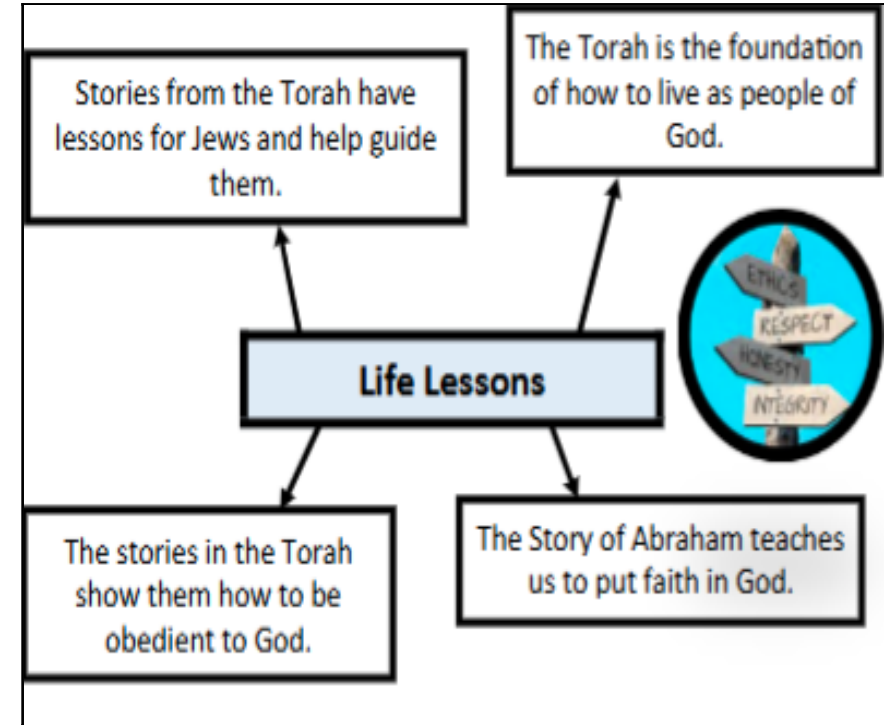

Shabbat	A day of rest on the seventh day.

The Torah was given to Moses when God made a promise with the Jewish people.



The Torah contains 613 rules that teach people how to live.

Moses and Abraham are both prophets of Judaism and their stories are shared in the Torah.
