*A Muslim's routine for prayer.....*




Arrive at the Mosque

Lay out a prayer mat




Pray together

## Key facts about Islam:



An Islamic place of worship is called a **Mosque**.

The special texts for Muslims is called the **Qur'an**.



## Vocabulary you will learn:

Shahada	The special sentence Muslims say to show they believe in one God (Allah) and that Prophet Muhammad is His messenger.
Wudu	Washing parts of the body (like hands, face, and feet) to get clean before praying.
Salah	The special prayer Muslims do five times every day to talk to Allah.
Mosque	A special building where Muslims go to pray and learn about Islam.
submission	Listening to and following Allah because you love and trust Him.
