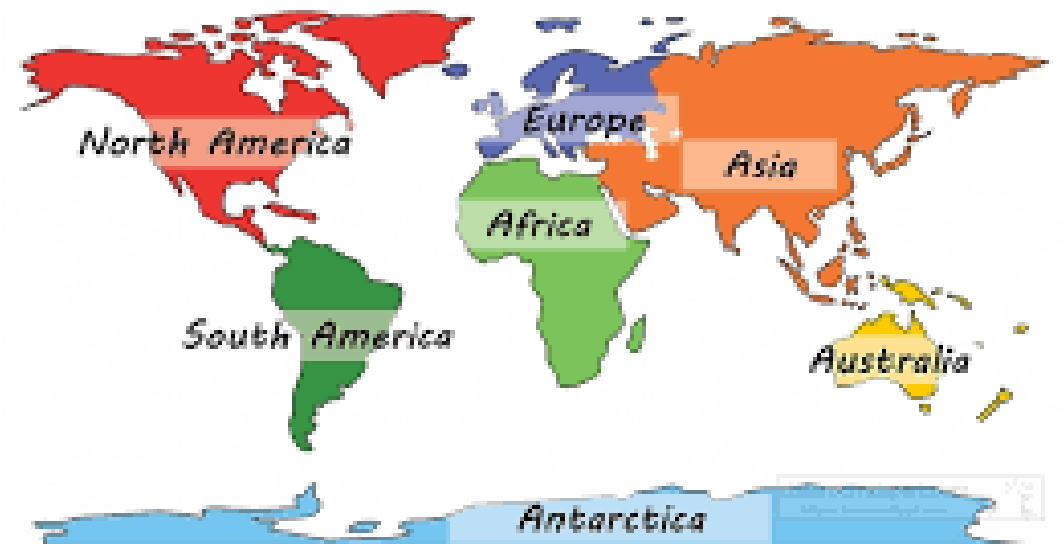
ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY

Key Concepts

There are 7 continents: Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Europe Australasia
There are 5 oceans: Pacific (largest), Atlantic, Indian, Southern, Arctic (smallest)
The Equator is an imaginary line around the middle of the Earth. Place on the Equator are very hot.
The North and South Poles are very cold.
North, East, South and West are the four main compass directions.
The UK is cooler and Kenya is hotter.
Pollution harms oceans.
Plastic can be harmful or helpful.
We can reduce, re-use and recycle plastic.
