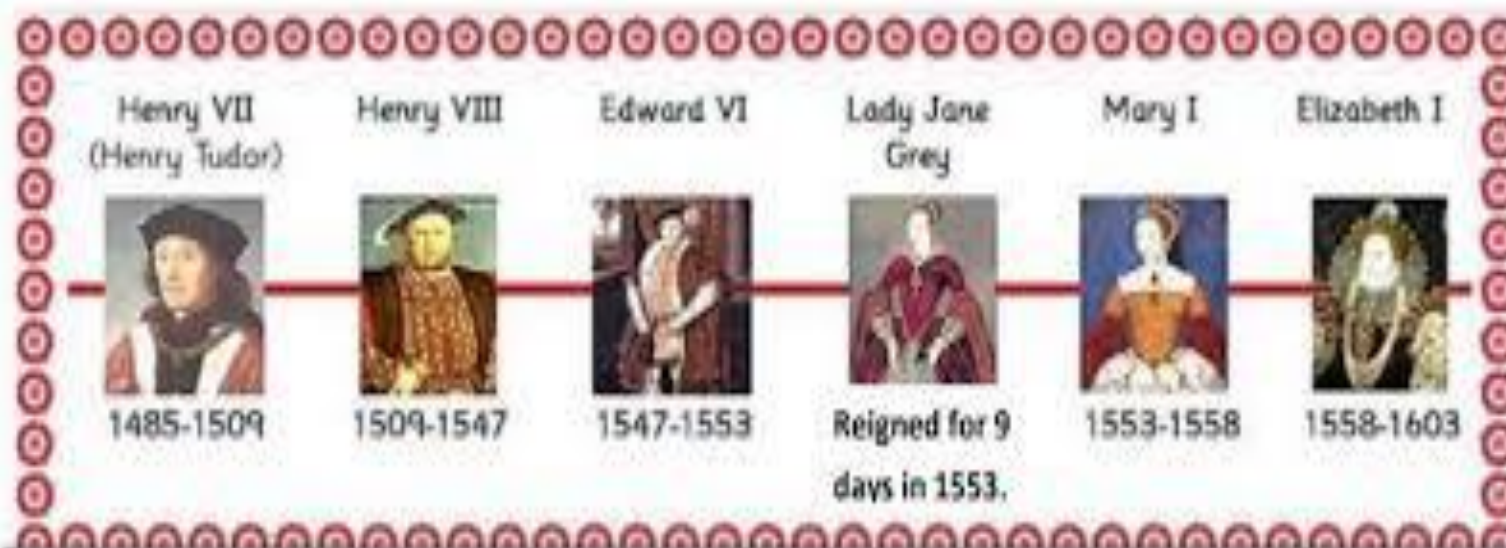
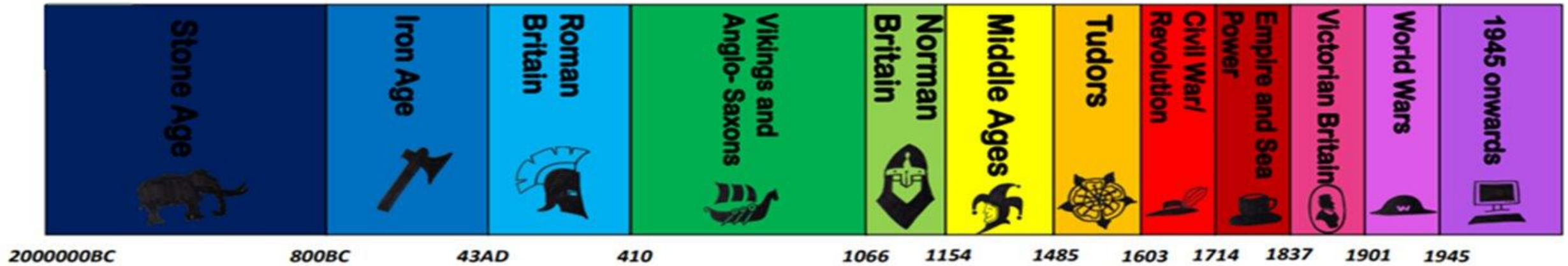

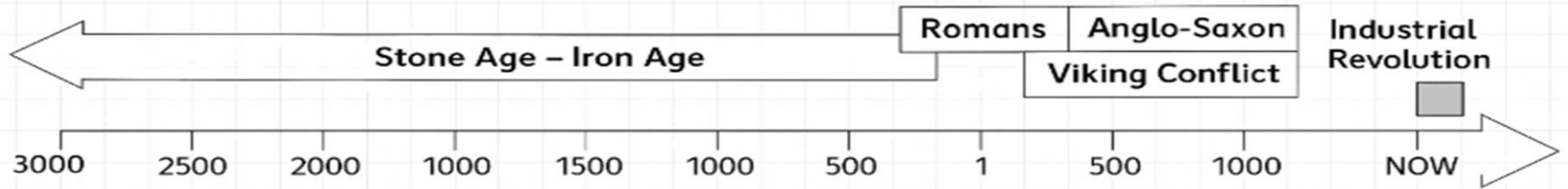

| Reformation | An act of changing a religious, political or societal institution for the better. |

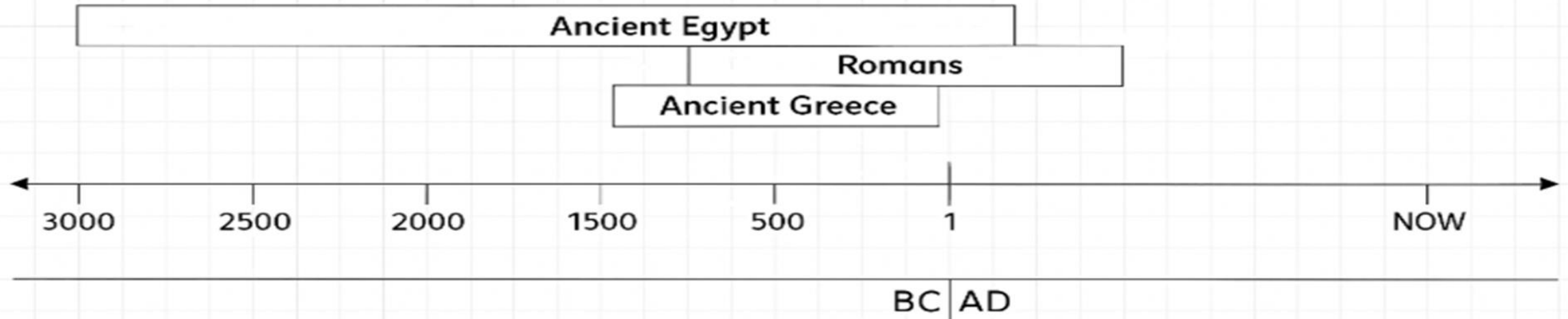

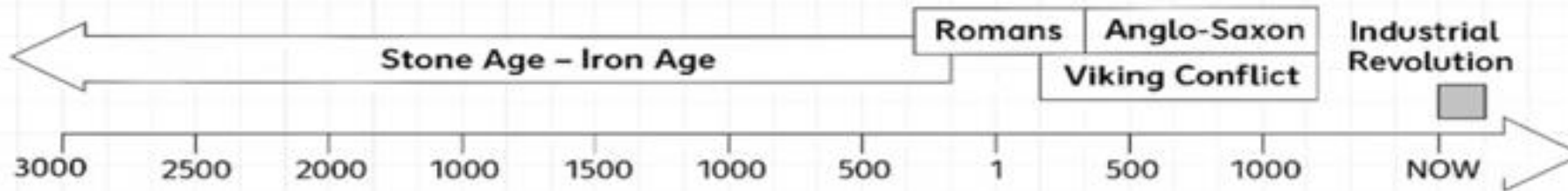
