

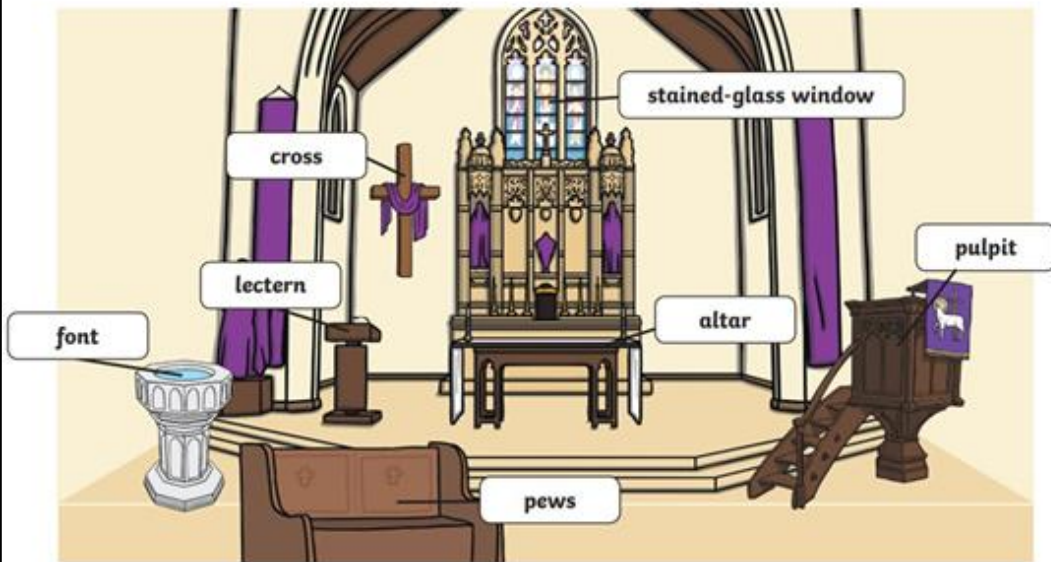

Religious Beliefs and Traditions:

The inside of a Christian Church



- Christians believe that the Church is a community.
- All Christians worship in different ways but there are some common practices.
- Christians' beliefs and values are a way of unifying the community.
- Within the Churches you may find significant items like a pulpit, lectern, altar and font.

Key facts about Christianity :



A Christian place of worship is called a **Church**.

The **Bible** is the Holy book for Christians.



Vocabulary you will learn:

Church	A special place where Christians go to pray, sing, and learn about God.
pulpit	A raised place in a church where the priest or speaker stands to talk to people.
lectern	A stand in a church where someone puts a book and reads from it, like the Bible.
alter	A special table in a church used for important services
prayer	Talking or listening to God.
Bible	A special holy book for Christians that tells stories and teachings about God.
Font	A bowl in a church that holds water used for baptisms.
