habitat	A place where a plant or animal lives.

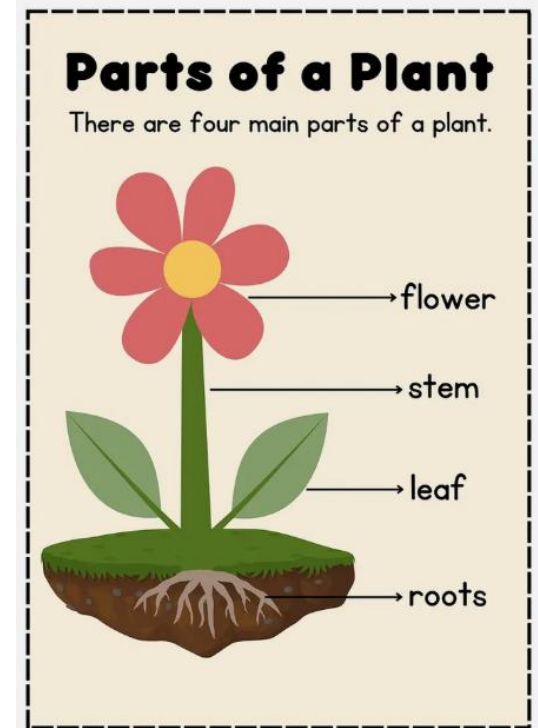
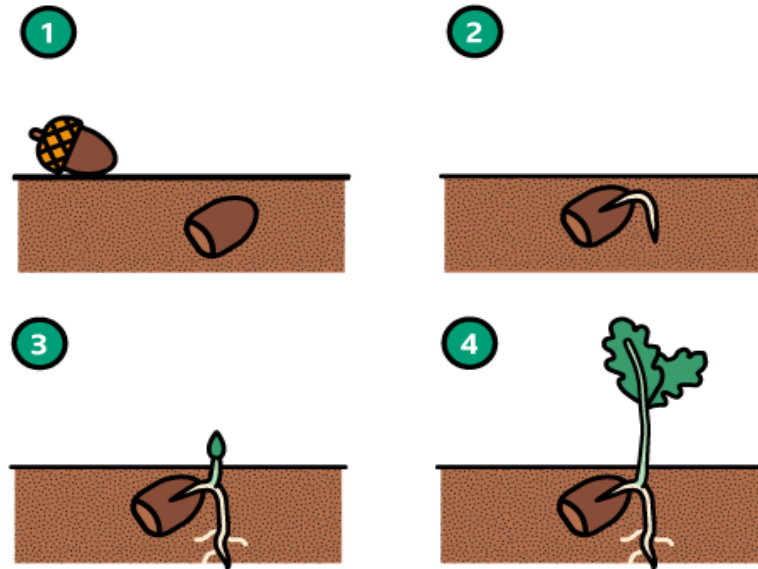
