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Dear Parents

I find it hard to believe that we have only one week left until the end of the Summer Term. Although it seems so long ago that the lockdown announcement was first made, in other ways the time seems to have flown by. I know that so many of our families have faced challenges along the way and I am grateful for the support that you have provided to your children.

I am hoping shortly to be in a position to give you more information about what will be in place in September based on the revised Government Guidelines. We are currently in the process of completing the required risk assessments before we are able to share final arrangements with you. Sadly, my lovely father-in-law passed away last week and therefore I am not as far on with the process as I had intended to be. I am able to tell you however, that we are anticipating we will be open to all children in all year groups from Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September. Reception will, as usual be on a part time basis initially. We have not yet determined the size of the bubbles, start times and finish times for each year bubble or if we will be able to offer before and after school club. We will of course let you know the final details as soon as we have agreed them with the Governors.

### Transition

As I mentioned in last Monday's newsletter, this week we are focusing on your child's transition to their new year group. Therefore much of the home learning relates to preparing your child for their move to a new year group and I know that your child's new class teacher is looking forward to seeing any work which is sent in.

We have added videos to our website of next year's class teacher reading a story for the children moving into Years 1-5. This can be found by clicking 'Learning', selecting your child's new year group, then clicking on the 'What we are learning' section. The videos will, I am sure, be particularly useful for children moving into Year 5 and Year 2 who may not be as familiar with Miss Fiddler and Ms Norris respectively.

There is also a video for the two year groups with the biggest transition: Year R to Year 1 where Mrs Culshaw and Mrs Coxon have shared information for parents and then photographs for the children; Year 2 for Year 3 where Miss Fiddler and Mrs Eccles have shared information and photographs for the children.

Finally, your child's current class teacher should also have emailed a link and password to a zoom 'transition session' where your child will have a chance to say goodbye to their old class teacher and a brief 'hello' to their new teacher.

Whilst none of the above can replace our traditional moving up day, hopefully it will go some way to alleviating some of the worries that you or your children may have.

## **End of Year Reports**

The teachers have prepared end of year reports for all our children. These will be sent home with the children in school and available to collect on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> for parents of children not in school. Any reports not collected by the end of the day will be posted home.
