### Congratulations on a Super First Week Back!

I have been keeping in regular contact with Ms Norris this week and I have been delighted to hear how hard the children have been working – I am very proud of them - very well done!

### Zig Zag Lines

At last night's Governors' meeting concern was expressed about the number of parents continuing to park on the zig zag lines resulting in pedestrians not being able to walk on the pavement and having to walk on the road. Clearly this puts our children's safety at considerable risk.

Please can I remind all parents that it is illegal to stop for any length of time on the zig zag lines and that traffic wardens are conducting regular unannounced checks. They take photos of the license plates of any illegally parked cars and fines are sent in the post.

To minimise congestion on Nelson Street and Woodlands Avenue, the Governors ask that wherever possible cars don't come down these roads and instead that parents park on nearby streets and walk to drop off/collect their child.

### EU Settlement Scheme

We have been asked by Lancashire County Council to share the following information:

The EU Settlement Scheme has been set up to provide immigration status to those who need it as the UK leaves the EU. EEA citizens, and their family members, will no longer be able to rely on the right of free movement and will need to obtain Immigration Status to demonstrate their right to remain in the UK.
