Her last official date as a member of staff here at KWPS was Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June.

Daryl has been a valued member of our staff team for over 20 years and during this time has made a big difference to the lives of so many of our pupils and families. She will be very much missed by staff, pupils and parents alike but her long term health must be her priority.
