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Ideas for activities with TU numbers

- Pick two numbers count between them. Count forwards and backwards.
- What is number before? What is the number after?
- Pick three numbers and put them in order.
- Pick a number and write it in words.
- Which number is between 26 and 28?
- Which numbers are between 20 and 28?
- Pick two numbers – which is the greatest/smallest?
- How many tens in the number?
- How many units in the number?
- Which number has 5 tens, 8 units etc?
- What is ten more/less?
- Pick a number and round it to the nearest 10.
- Roll a dice and add/subtract the number on the dice to the TU number.
- Pick a number. What is 9 more/less?
- Pick a number. What is 11 more/less?
- Pick a number start counting forwards and backwards in 2/5/10/3/4/6/8/9 from this number.
- Use two TU numbers and add/subtract them.
- Use two numbers. Which number comes half way between?
- Roll a dice and multiply the number on the dice to the TU number.
- Pick two numbers and multiply them together.
- Pick 4 cards – use the digits to make two 2 decimal place numbers. Add/subtract the numbers together
- Pick a number and identify all the factors of that number
- Pick a number. Here is the target number/answer but what could be the calculation.
- Pick 3 or 4 numbers. Add them together.
