Facebook

I know many parents access the Facebook page which we set up during lockdown. COVID Update – Testing and Self Isolating

Many of you have struggled to access tests this week and are as frustrated as we are at the current testing situation. Thank you for your patience! The difficulty in accessing tests and the potential long wait for results is impacting on pupils, parents and staff alike. As a result, we have been operating school with a vastly reduced staffing level and I must congratulate the children for continuing to work so hard and with such enthusiasm this week and the staff who have been covering so many different roles to ensure that we were able to remain open and COVID secure.

Over 30 tests have been completed by members of our school community, and (apart from the one positive result right at the start of term which we informed all our parents about), thankfully they have all been negative. Whilst we recognise how disruptive it is for our children and staff to be self-isolating whilst waiting for their test result after such a short time back in school, we are all required to adhere to the Government guidance for the safety of our pupils, families, staff and the wider community.

For individual children who are required to self-isolate, we are trying to minimise the disruption by providing work which is being emailed out by the classteacher. Please do bear in mind that as the classteachers are teaching all day they are unlikely to be able to respond to an email until the end of the school day.

Mrs Coxon and the Year 1 parents have been trialling an online system called ClassDojo to share the home learning and we have received some good feedback about this.

Secondary School Admissions

If your child is in our current Year 6, you need to apply online for their secondary school by 31st October. Please note that this is a strict deadline and applications sent after this time will not be considered until all the 'on time' pupils have been allocated a place. This could result in your child not getting the school they want.

Flu Vaccinations

We have been notified that all children from R to Y6 are being given the option to have flu vaccinations this year. These are administered by a quick spray up the nose and will take place in school on November 18th.

A letter giving more details and a consent form was sent home on Friday. **Please note that the vaccination cannot be administered without parental permission. If you do wish your children to receive it, the form needs to be returned to school by next Friday 25th September.**

Dropping Off and Collection Times

As Year 1 parents and children will be returning on Monday it will become a little busier on Nelson Street. We are more than happy for parents of Year 1 and 3 to come into the playground and stand socially distant on a footstep with your child so the pavement doesn't become too busy.

We are required to keep our class bubbles separate at drop off and collection times. Therefore, if your child is in Year 2, 4 or Year 6 please ensure that they don't arrive at school before 8.50am. Children from these year groups shouldn't enter the playground until the previous class have gone into school.
