<b>Daily activities</b>
Bug Club reading Remember to use the comprehension book marks given out at Parents evening
Phonics All purple books, sounds packs and word packs are complete with all Phase 3 sounds. Please practise reading sentences and writing sentences using these sounds.
Maths Numbers to 20. Can your child recognise, read and order numbers to 20. Can they say a number one more or one less? Can they mentally add or subtract to 20? Remember counting on method. (discussed at parents evening)
Count to 100 in 1s, 5s and 10s

<b>At least once a week activities</b>	Date	Comment
Play board games. Dominoes sent home at start of Reception year.		
Maths Snakes and Ladders / Summer game – in pack. Practise addition and subtraction using counting on and counting back.		
Phonics Write a phonics sentence. Remember full stops, capital letters and spaces. Try to sit letters on the line and keep your handwriting neat (sheets are in pack)		

Write a short story about what you have been doing.		
Spring Take a walk around your garden, draw a picture of what changes you notice. Write a sentence to go with your picture.
