

LITERACY

Stories with Historical Settings

- To read, explore and write in the style of a historical novel.
- To explore and develop characters and settings.
- To use “ing” sentence openers.

Film and Play Scripts

- To justify opinions by referring to the text (Point + Evidence + Explanation).
- Prepare, read aloud, perform and write play scripts.

Classical Narrative Poems

- To read, explore, prepare and read aloud classic narrative poems.

NUMERACY

- Mental x and ÷ - know factors, multiples, common factors, prime numbers, square numbers, use known facts to assist with multiplications sums.
- Division including problems—written chunking calculations
- Fractions—compare, order, count on and find equivalent fractions
- Multiplication— written multiplication grids and calculating area
- Statistics—reading digital and analogue times, converting times between 12 and 24 hour clocks. Read and interpret timetables. Solve problems including converting units of time.

GEOGRAPHY

- Name and locate countries around the world and look where our food comes from.
- Use, understand and interpret digital maps, atlases and globes.
- Relate weather, climate and soil influences to farming produce grown.
- To consider and understand what is meant by Fairtrade and Red Tractor Farm products.
