

**LITERACY**

Stories from Other Cultures

- To use suffixes accurately and convert nouns and adjectives into verbs.
- To explore themes across texts and stories.
- To create, punctuate and use *-ed* and *-ing* sentence openers.
- To develop ideas, plan and write a story based in the Amazon.

Debate

- To explore, collect and use modal verbs to indicate degrees of possibility.
- To prepare individual and group formal presentations.
- To participate in debates giving reasonable points of views.

**NUMERACY**

- Mental Arithmetic—to know all tables to 12 x 12
- Place Value—Read, write, order and partition numbers to 100000 and with up to 3 decimal places. Count forwards and back in decimal steps. Round numbers.
- Fractions—Recognise and convert mixed and improper fractions. Identify equivalent fractions. Add and subtract fractions.
- Measures—Read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12 and 24 hour clocks. Read and interpret timetables. Solve problems with units of time.
- Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division—Add and subtraction more than 4 digits and with up to 2 decimal places. Multiply and divide up to 4 digits by 1 digit. Recognise cubed and squared numbers. Solve multi-step problems.

**SCIENCE**

- To learn about and describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.
- To describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.
- To name and know the purpose of the key parts of a plant and flower.
- To observe, compare and suggest similarities and differences during scientific experiments
- To learn about the scientist David Attenborough.
