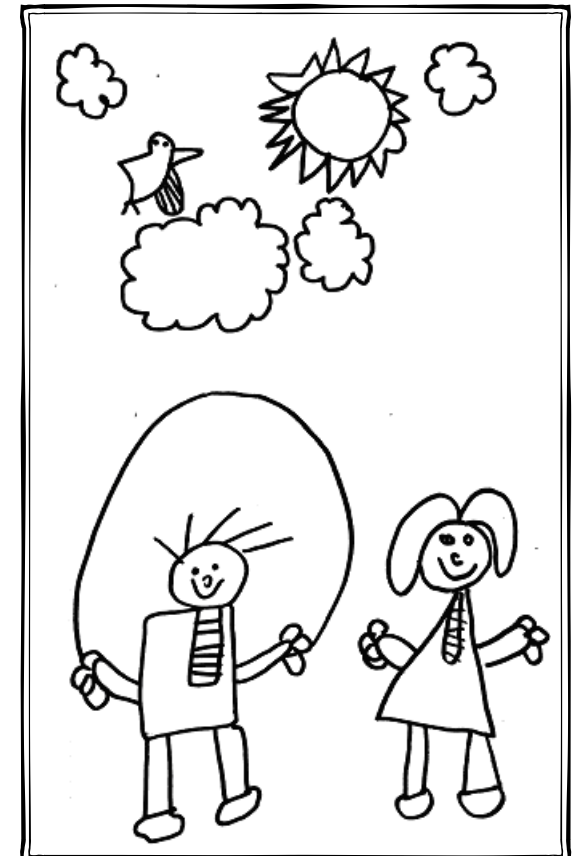


## Infant Behaviour Policy
