Skip2BeFit Workshop

The school council organised a day's visit from a Skip2BeFit coach, David, who ran skipping sessions for every class on Wednesday. He used special skipping ropes that count the number of skips completed in 2 minutes and it proved a real hit with the children. We saw some impressively fast skipping and high totals from both staff and children! We have bought some of the skipping ropes for school so that the children can continue to practise and try and beat their own score.

The day ended with an assembly where the coach presented a certificate to the child in each class with the most skips in 2 minutes. Congratulations to Alexander in Y3 who had the highest total of all the children and Mrs Taylor who topped the staff leaderboard!
