### Secondary School Admissions

If your child is in our current Year 6, you need to apply online for their secondary school by 31st October. Please note that this is a strict deadline and applications sent after this time will not be considered until all the 'on time' pupils have been allocated a place. This could result in your child not getting the school they want.

To apply please go to www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools and click on 'apply for a school place'.

**Do you have a child who turns 4 between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020?** If you do, they are due to start school in September 2020. However your child will not automatically be allocated a place at our school unless you apply online at www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools **before January 15th 2020**. As we are not a church school, it is Lancashire Education Authority who allocate places and although they will always give priority to children who already have a sibling attending the school ~ this only applies if the application is submitted on time.

Please note we have been oversubscribed in the past and children with siblings already at school have missed out on a place as they didn't apply before the closing date. We are trying to remind parents when we know there is a sibling of pre-school age however we can't guarantee we will speak to everybody.
