Our remote education provision is delivered exclusively through **Class Dojo**, which provides a secure, accessible, and interactive platform for all teaching and learning activities.

Messages will be sent via Class Dojo to **notify parents of the school closure and the remote learning plan**.

Tasks, links to resources, and instructions for all subjects will be set directly within the Class Dojo platform.

Pupil Learning and Assessment

We utilise the **Class Dojo Portfolio** feature to manage the learning cycle.

- Setting Tasks: Teachers will set specific assignments and activities, including instructions, videos, or links to external resources, which appear directly in the pupil's Portfolio feed.
- Submitting Work: Pupils are required to use their Class Dojo Portfolios to upload their completed work. This might be a photograph of written work, a document, a video, or an image of a creative activity.
- **Feedback:** Teachers will **check the submitted work** via the Portfolios and feedback will be provided to pupils **online** using the tools available within Class Dojo.
- Expected Engagement: Pupils are expected to engage with and complete the set tasks as they would during a normal school day. Teachers will monitor engagement and provide support as needed.
