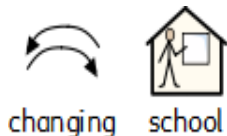


## What have we done

January to the end March 2019



NEL have recruited an additional **Educational Psychologist**  
 NEL have advertised for **2 additional EHCP co-ordinators**  
 NEL have advertised for a **Access Pathway coordinator**



Our '**Best Practice Transitions**' pilot project with Delta Academy Trust has started.

The Young People's SEND Advisory Group (YPAG) have **designed their own logo** and are **redesigning the EHCP format**.



**33 parents/carers attended FREE workshops** to help them support their child's mental health and emotional wellbeing.

**40 Young people were supported by School Nurses** using Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) approach.

**Health visitors have improved the number of children seen** at their two—two and a half year check to **89%**.

**78 young people, parents/carers, and professionals** took part in the independent **Access Pathway review** with Healthwatch.

A range of partners including **parent/carers have co-produced** a new **access pathway referral form**.

**75 people** attended 2 workshops on planning how to change the process of asking for an assessment of SEND and an EHCPs. Parent/carers took part in an EHCP workshop to review and revise our EHCP documents in NEL

**More than 25 schools** have signed up for a '**How to guide to setting up and developing a parent/carer SEND support group in your school**' workshop - taking place in May 2019.
